## What is the Citizens Program?

The Best Buddies Illinois Citizens Program provides opportunities for one-to-one friendships for adults (18+) with and without IDD. Buddy Pairs commit to one year of friendship, get together 1-2 times each month, and share communication each week.

## Does it cost anything?

Once matched, participants are responsible for their own costs when on an outing.

How are matches made? Matches are based on same gender, location, common interests, and similar age.
