OUR BEST BUDDIES MISSION

Best Buddies® is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to establishing a global volunteer movement that creates opportunities for one-to-one friendships, integrated employment, leadership development and inclusive living for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). Best Buddies programs engage participants in each of the 50 United States, and in 54 countries around the world. Best Buddies' nine formal programs — Middle Schools, High Schools, Colleges, Citizens, e-Buddies®, Jobs, Ambassadors, Promoters, and Inclusive Living — positively impacts more than 1.25 million individuals with and without disabilities worldwide.

Our champions raise the funds needed so that everyone can have a best friend.





WHY CHAMPION OF THE YEAR?

It is often said that we are the product of the company that we keep. Given a choice, we surround ourselves with people who challenge us, comfort us, lift us up, and make us feel at home.

People with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD), however, don't often have this choice. Years of isolation in school and in the community contribute to overwhelming loneliness as they struggle to find where they fit. Having a disability does not change the deep desire to be known by a true friend, and to be one in return.

Best Buddies' programs allow students and adults with IDD to take part in age-appropriate social activities through one-to-one friendships with their peers.

Champion of the Year nominees turn this vision into a reality.

Through monthly group activities and talking with their new friend at least once a week, people with IDD get to experience friendship that we might take for granted — all while building a life-giving social network outside of their families and service providers.

Champions provide the necessary funding for us expand our vision to new schools and communities, bringing us one step closer to making sure that every student and adult with IDD gets to experience true friendship. The efforts of each Champion nominee create a lasting impact that extends far beyond the eight weeks of their campaign.



WHAT IS CHAMPION OF THE YEAR?

Champion of the Year unites and recognizes the community's most active leaders in the name of inclusion.

Through 8-12 weeks of raising funds and awareness for **Best Buddies**, our Champions will generate countless opportunities for friendships, jobs, and leadership development for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. At the campaign's conclusion, we will join together to celebrate each other's accomplishments, honor the Champions' collective impact, and name the ultimate Champion of the Year!

CHAMPION NOMINATION CRITERIA

Champion of the Year nominees are selected based on their individual, professional and philanthropic achievements as well as their passion for the **Best Buddies** mission.

Nominees are compassionate, socially engaged, well-networked and dedicated to making a difference in their community for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

CAMPAIGN SUPPORT

Support will start during the candidate training and strategy planning session and will continue through the Champion of the Year Gala.

Each Candidate will have the opportunity to appoint their own Campaign Manager to assist with their campaign.

A Mission Partner will be assigned to each candidate to help provide mission related support.


Local Best Buddies staff and Volunteer Planning Committee will provide support and encouragement to each candidate.
